Post baccalaureate and post doctoral fellows will conduct mentored theoretical and empirical research related to the ethics of health policy,

human subject research, international research ethics, genetics, or other

bioethical fields of interest. For a typical fellow, this research yields

multiple publications in premier academic journals. Fellows will participate in case conferences, ethics consultations, review of research protocols, bioethics seminars and many other educational opportunities. No bioethics experience required or expected. Two-year positions begin September 2013. Students planning to pursue MD, JD, PhD or

other graduate degrees or those who have achieved these degrees are encouraged to apply. Salary is commensurate with Federal guidelines.
