as Assistant Professor 2 years term in Tokyo

- a. PhD in Oral Biology, Biochemistry, Cell Biology or Periodontology is required.
- b. Non-native English speaker is acceptable, but must speak good English.
- c. Japanese language skill is not required.
- d. Your project is Stem Cell research of the pulp. Already we have a great progress, so you have a part of project for differentiation of the cells for cosmetic surgery.
- e. Salary is estimated to be approximately \$40000 **after tax, pension and etc. Rate: 95Yen = a dollar.** It is more than enough to live in Tokyo.
- f. **Travel stipend for a round trip will be paid.**
- g. Estimate publications are **2-4 per year with collaborating with my PhD students**
