I know many of you use the CRISP system to look at what the NIH and other Federal agencies are funding. I thought you might be interested in this news item:

The CRISP system has been retired as of September 1, 2009, and replaced by the RePORT Expenditures and Results (RePORTER) module. CRISP will remain available until November 1, 2009 to allow users to transition, but CRISP support is no longer being provided.
